

# Grading Criteria for Case Study

Each group will be graded on overall presentation, knowledge of information, analysis, safe and proper application of respiratory treatment modalities. In addition, each member will rate the other members in determining their value and contribution to the group. That rating will be on a scale of 1-10 with 1 one being the lowest and reflects a group member that is not to be a valuable part of the group in terms of group participation and contribution to the case research. A rating of 10 reflects a member has made a significant participation and contribution to the case study research. The member rating will be averaged and score to be added to the grade received from the panel. For fairness, group will be based on drawing numbers from a hat.

1. Verbal and Written Presentation - 5 points maximum
  - A group representative must give a brief report about the patient to the panel.
  - Must be type written in SOAP format with enough copies made for panel and students.
2. Gathering pertinent patient information and interpretation  
(Chief complaints, H&P, medical history, labs, x-rays, etc.) - 5 points maximum
3. Formulation of impression or assessment of patient - 5 point maximum
4. Knowledge of disease process - 5 points maximum
5. Plan and/or provide proper patient intervention - 5 points maximum
  - Knowledge of respiratory therapy interventions, pharmacology, treatment modalities, their indication, expected outcome, hazards and contraindications.

A total of 35 points can be achieved for the case study. Twenty-five points will be based on the above grading criteria and the remaining 10 points will be from the average of the rating that the group member will give to each other.
